The Oak Ridge National Environmental Research Park (NERP) serves as a training ground for future researchers and students from kindergarten to graduate school as well as faculty and community members. NERP educational programs have reached more than 85,000 pre-college students and teachers during the past five years. In addition, as a result of its designation as an User Facility for Oak Ridge National Laboratory, the NERP has attracted more than 700 students and researchers from colleges, universities, industries, and other state and federal government agencies over the past five years.
