OAK RIDGE RESERVATION LAND-USE PLANNING STAKEHOLDERS' MEETING

I appreciate your concerns regarding long-term, land-use planning for the Oak Ridge Reservation (ORR) as expressed in your letter of September 5, 2000. I would like to assure you that we are now in the beginning stages of revitalizing and revising our Oak Ridge Operations Office Comprehensive Integrated Planning (ORO/CIP) document, which will describe what is planned for the ORR, both near- and long-term. Our Internet site (<http://www.oakridge.doe.gov/supporting.html>) provides an electronic copy of the current document and has also been placed in the DOE Public Reading Room. The 1999 edition of this document was developed with stakeholder review; however, I recognize the need to improve that process to one of greater stakeholder involvement.

As suggested in the July 5 meeting, we plan to bring the ORR stakeholders together in a joint meeting to determine what the key issues are and what can be done to resolve the concerns surrounding usage of the ORR. This initial meeting is currently being scheduled to take place within the next 90 days. We are committed to this meeting and follow-on meetings and workshops to ensure that we have captured and considered stakeholders' ideas concerning land usage on the ORR. There will be an opportunity for further comment during the development of this document as part of a formalized comment process.
